UPenn Study Reveals Big Barker Beds Improve a Dog's Quality of Life

(King of Prussia, PA) August 17, 2020 – Last month, Big Barker (BB) released the results of a pilot study that revealed the positive effects of Big Barker beds. The University of Pennsylvania's School of Veterinary Medicine (UPenn) conducted research over the past three years, leading to the conclusion that a BB dog bed can dramatically impact a dog's quality of life.

The study was proposed after Big Barker donated beds to PennVet's Working Dog Center, whose doctors noticed the beds' benefits on their patients. UPenn asked BB if they would consider taking part in a clinical study to see if their bed improved a dog's quality of life and warranted additional studies. The significant data suggests the potential for further research.

The study enrolled 40 dogs weighing over 70 pounds and older than three years. Data was collected by dog owners and activity monitors worn on the dogs' collars for 28 days. The <u>independent data</u> shows that Big Barker beds, on average, led to:

- Nearly 18% improvement in joint function
- 21% reduction in pain severity
- Over 12% reduction in joint stiffness
- About 10% improvement in gait
- 15% improvement to quality of life

Eric Shannon, president of Big Barker, says, "we've been saying for years that real beds change lives. Now, there's proof and we couldn't be prouder to present these findings!"
